Geography- Australia

Continent	A massive area of land that is separated from others by water or other natural features.
Sydney	A large city in Australia.
City	A large town.
Town	A built up area where people live and work.
Physical features	Natural features of land.
Human features	Features of land that have been impacted by human activity.
Population	The number of people that live there.
Location	A site or position.
Climate	The general weather conditions of an area.
Landmarks	A building or feature which is easily recognisable.

Indigenous Australians were the first people to live in Australia. They used weapons like spears and boomerangs to hunt animals, such as kangaroos and emus. They also gathered fruit, honey and eggs. They have unique art and pass their history on through songs and stories.

Physical features:

Human features:

Town, school, shops, church, house, farm and playground.

Landmarks:

Sydney Harbour Bridge, Barrier Reef, Sydney Opera House, Barrier Reef and Bondi Beach.
