
Key Stage 1 — Summer 2nd - Our United Kingdom

We will be comparing nurses today and what it was like when Edith and Florence were alive. We will also be learning why they are significant individuals.








Session 1

L.O: I am learning to select and use tools, skills and techniques to make my product.


We will be making our own bridges using a range of tools.

and make predictions about further changes.




Session 2
