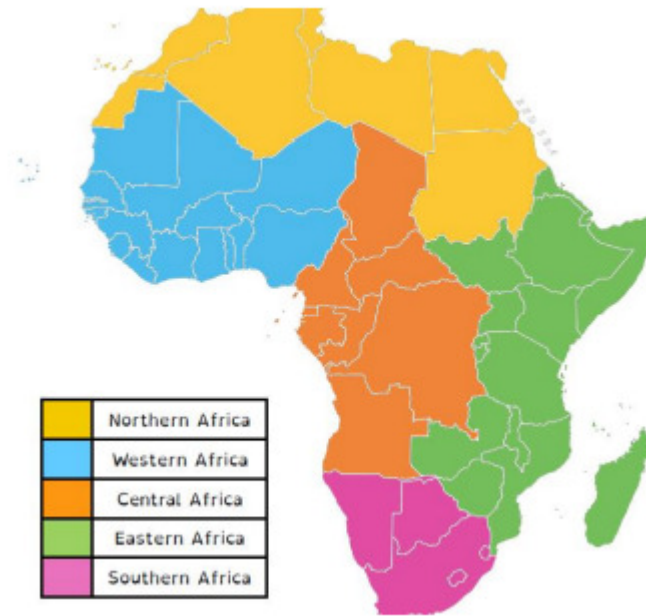

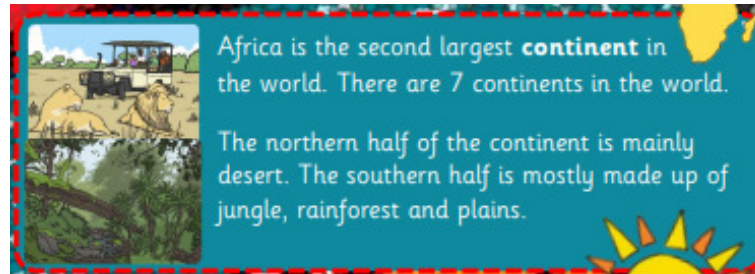
Knowledge Organiser- Amazing Africa

Continent	A large area of land that is joined together . There are 7 continents on Earth.
Country	A country is land that is controlled by a single government.
Landscape	Means an area of land as you can see it.
Culture	The ideas, customs and behaviours of a group of people/
Safari	An overland journey , usually by tourists and in Africa.
Savanah	A grassy plain with a few trees .
Tourist	Someone who is visiting a place for pleasure.
National Park	A National Park is a protected area of land,
Endangered species	When a species of animal or plant is at risk of becoming extinct
Extinct	When a species will never be alive again.
