
Key Stage 1 — Spring 2nd - The Deep Blue Sea



SCIENCE PLANTS (Year 2)

Session 1: Science

LO: I am learning to Identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees

ASSESSMENT

We will be looking at a selection of seeds and

bulbs and discussing what we notice about them. Then we will be completing a KWL grid.



Session 2: Science

LO: I am learning to observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants

We will be making observational drawings of seeds and bulbs. We will be looking at them carefully with a magnifying glass.



Session 3: Science

LO: I am learning to observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants

We will be planting an amaryllis bulb. Over the next month we will be keeping an eye on it, looking for how it changed and measuring it.

L.O: I am learning to find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy


We will be planting our own seeds and keeping some in our dark cupboard to observe what happens and to find out what plants need to grow.

L.O: I am learning to find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy


We will be writing a diary of what happens each week to our seeds when they are kept in different places.

We will be exploring maps and looking at the world and locating the continents and five oceans.




Session 2: Geography

L.O: I am learning to begin to understand the difference between countries and continents.


We will be learning about the differences between countries and continents. We will exploring some countries on our map and learning what continents they are in.



Session 5: Geography

L.O: I am learning to match-up satellite / aerial photos with maps to support my understanding of maps.

We will be exploring lots of different aerial pictures and finding these places on our maps. We will be exploring google maps.





ART- Painting

Session 1: Art

LO: I am learning about an artist.

We will be looking at Vincent Van Gogh paintings and learning about him. We will be discussing his artwork and what we like about it.



Session 2: Art

LO: I am learning to use a variety of tools and techniques including the use of different brush sizes and types.

We will be exploring using water colours. We will be using a variety of tools to create this.



Session 3: ART

L.O: I am learning to explore techniques such as lightening and darkening paint without the use of black or white.

We will be looking closely at the Vincent Van Gogh's picture and talking about how he has used black and white to create a realistic painting.





LO: I am learning to create different textures e.g. use of sawdust.

We will be u using water colours to create a masterpiece of the 'sea' using Vincent Van Gogh's work to help us. We will be using a variety of tools to create this.

We will then look at using different textures such as adding saw dust to our paint to see what this creates.
